


What is the unborn?

Distinct: the unborn is different in kind to his/her mother. He/she has a unique genetic make-up.




Gametes – made up of the parent, but not the parent. Lots of possibilities of combinations with another opposite sex gamete.



If someone shares that they are pregnant...

- Reassure them
- Ask them how they feel (everyone else will be asking 'what are you going to do about that?')
- Ask them if they need support, and if so, what?
- Point them in the direction of further help what does your uni/church/school/local community offer? Is there crisis pregnancy support nearby?
- Listen

If someone shares they've had an abortion...

- The first words out of your mouth: 'I am so sorry you went through that'
- Be compassionate
- O How do they feel about that now?
- Are they comfortable sharing more? Why did they feel they needed an abortion?
- Point them in the direction of post-abortion counselling
- Initially after an abortion they may experience a sense of relief, this then becomes distress

Our UK Abortion Law



'de facto', we have abortion on demand for any reason up to 24 weeks. Up to birth for disability.

Changes to the Law

- Sex-selective abortion, 2015
- Northern Ireland, October 2019
- DIY at home abortions, 2020
- Abortion on demand (decrim), on going
- · Heidi Crowter, on going





Some statistics

- 214,869 in England and Wales in 2021
- Equates to 588 abortions per day of the year
- 41% of these were repeat abortions
- Women aged 20-24 highest likelihood of abortion than all other age groups

British pro-life advocate again arrested for 'thoughtcrime' of silent prayer near abortion clinic







So why does Abortion matter?



Reasons for Abortion

Grounds A and B: permit abortion where the risk to the life of the mother is greater if she continues her pregnancy than if she doesn't, and to prevent grave permanent injury to physical or mental health.

121

Ground C: permits abortion if there is a risk to the mental or physical 205,930 health of the mother if she continues her pregnancy.

Ground D and E give permission for abortion if the unborn child is 3,859 found to be disabled or have any abnormalities.

Grounds F and G permit abortion where the mother's life will be saved through the abortion.
