

TORBAY ORDINARIATE APPEAL FOR FUNDS

If the Personal Ordinariate of Our Lady of Walsingham is to thrive in the way that Pope Benedict intended when he established it, its groups up and down the country need their own churches to set up as centres of worship and evangelisation and as tangible expressions of the Anglican patrimony which the Ordinariate brings to enrich the wider Catholic Church.

An opportunity has now arisen for the Ordinariate's Torbay Mission to buy this redundant Methodist church. The local Methodist community is keen to sell it to a Christian community so that the Christian flame is kept alight there. But to secure its purchase, the Ordinariate Torbay Mission needs urgently to raise £150,000; otherwise the church will have to be put on the open market.

There is a building included in the sale that could easily be converted to become a presbytery to house an Ordinariate priest.
